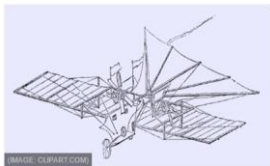


Inventions, aesthetic creations (design) and the distinctive signs used to distinguish products and businesses within the market.

Design

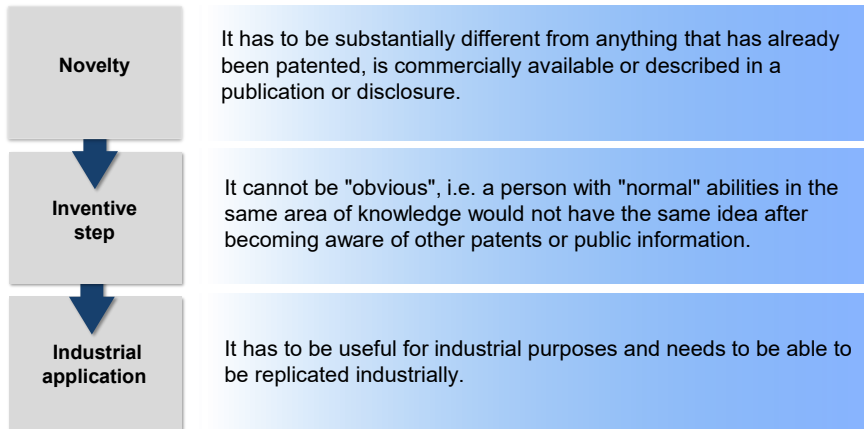


Appearance or design of an object (aesthetic configuration/creative activity of businesses and designers)

- Models

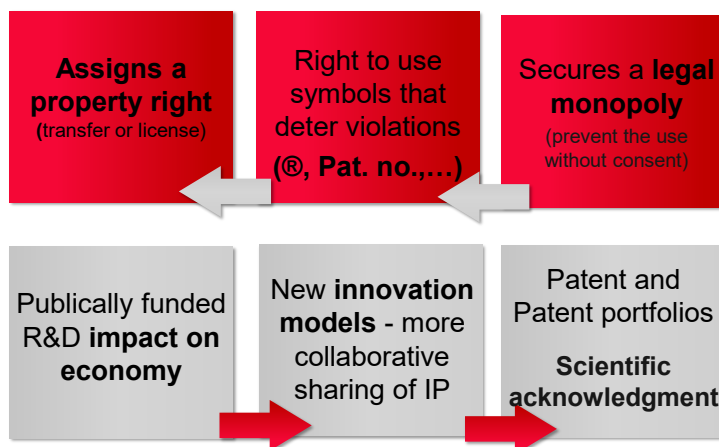

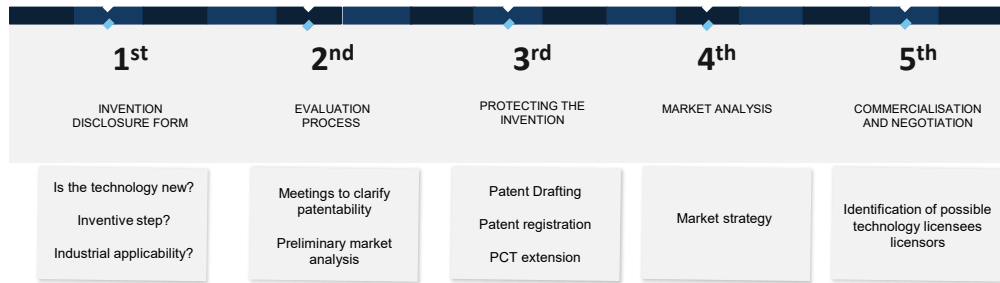
